## **Care and Control**

This disengagement and physical intervention training course is for Medium Risk environments and is delivered over 2 days and includes:

- Sector-specific training needs (ASD, Dementia, Brain Injury, EBD)



- Specific person procedures (for your patients, service users, or clients)

BTEC Level 2 Intermediate Award in Physical Restraint, Care & Control (Children & Young People)

to use handcuffs in the course of their job. The BTEC Level 2 Safe and Effective
Use of Restraint Equipment qualification provides the essential knowledge and
understanding of the legal framework and the effective practical skills in how to use
the equipment safely, efficiently and legally. The Handcuffing techniques taught are
fully in accordance with current Police guidelines and are Home Office approved
