Programme/Course Content

- CPR
- Choking
- Management of acute anaphylaxis
- Use of Emergency Equipment (oxygen, airway adjuncts and drugs)
- Cardiac Arrest Rhythms
- Use of the AED (if the surgery has one)
- Recognising and responding to asthma, diabetes, fainting, epilepsy, and myocardial infarction
- Assessment & Certification
