Programme/Course Content:

- Unit 1: Promote communication in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Unit 2: Engage in personal development in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Unit 3: Promote equality and inclusion in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Unit 4: Principles for implementing duty of care in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Unit 5: Principles of safeguarding and protection in health and social care
- Unit 6: The role of the health and social care worker
- Unit 7: Promote person centred approaches in health and social care
- Unit 8: Promote and implement health and safety in health and social Care
- Unit 9: Promote good practice in handling information in health and social care settings

Further information: Delegates will also be required to complete a number of optional knowledge and competence units which vary in accordance with their own working area – examples include supported living, infection control, working with adults with learning disabilities, dementia care and more. There will also be the choice of studying toward a focused qualification in a specific area like learning disability assessment or to choose a general health and social care pathway.

Candidates are assessed in accordance with a final portfolio of evidence, their work-based performance, feedback gathered from witnesses and by way of a series of monitored and measured questions. Only when the delegate has demonstrated full and accurate knowledge of the course materials will they be credited with the award.

A QCF Diploma assessor will assist each candidate in the preparation of materials prior to the final assessment taking place. There will also be the option of telephone and email support throughout the course to be used by delegates as and when required.
